Vision of health: new creation life (14)

Faithful and true | beginning of God's creation

Symptom of sickness: lukewarmness (15-16)

Underlying disease: numbing self-sufficiency (17)

you say | not realizing

Cure: repentance and fellowship (18-22)

I counsel you | be zealous and repent | I stand at the door and knock.
