Communion

Receiving communion is an active profession that, "I receive and rest on Jesus alone for salvation and humbly submit to his Lordship in my life."

During Communion today we ask you to go to a nearby table and receive the bread and (red) wine or (white) grape juice. You do not have to hurry through the line. Bring the bread and wine back to your seat and we will all partake together.

Should you take Communion?

This is a "means of grace"— a method of encouragement and spiritual nourishment from God for those who entrust themselves to Jesus Christ and have received the sign of baptism. This is not for perfect people, it's for broken people who are honest about their sin and trust in the mercy of Jesus. However, if you are harboring secret or unrepented sin or are in unaddressed conflict with another Christian, we ask that you first repent or go and be reconciled before coming to the table.

New City is happy to be a community where people are in process with what they believe and honestly struggle with sin and reconciliation. For this reason, it is not uncommon for folk to refrain from taking communion. If not participating in Communion today, we encourage you to pray through one of the prayers on the next page.

Children

Children who profess faith in Christ and have been approved to receive communion by the Elders of New City Church or the leaders of your home church are welcome to partake. Children not receiving communion are heartily welcomed to go through the line with their parents to observe what is happening.

Redemption is a Bigger Story

February 13, 2022 | Exodus 7-10 | Pastor Roger Williams

Redemption always involves a bigger story of God's glory for our good.

Exodus 3 ¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'I AM has sent me to you.'" ¹⁵ God also said to Moses, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is my name forever, and thus I am to be remembered throughout all generations. ¹⁶ Go and gather the elders of Israel together and say to them, "The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, has appeared to me, saying, "I have observed you and what has been done to you in Egypt, ¹⁷ and I promise that I will bring you up out of the affliction of Egypt...

Exodus 5 ¹ Afterward Moses and Aaron went and said to Pharaoh, "Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, 'Let my people go, that they may hold a feast to me in the wilderness." ²But Pharaoh said, "Who is the LORD, that I should obey his voice and let Israel go? I do not know the LORD, and moreover, I will not let Israel go."

Exodus 5 ¹⁰ So the taskmasters and the foremen of the people went out and said to the people, "Thus says Pharaoh, 'I will not give you straw..."

Exodus 6 ⁷I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

Exodus 7 ¹And the LORD said to Moses, "See, I have made you like God to Pharaoh, and your brother Aaron shall be your prophet. ² You shall speak all that I command you, and your brother Aaron shall tell Pharaoh to let the people of Israel go out of his land. ³ But I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and though I multiply my signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, ⁴ Pharaoh will not listen to you. Then I will lay my hand on Egypt and bring my hosts, my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great acts of judgment. ⁵ The Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the people of Israel from among them." ⁶ Moses and Aaron did so; they did just as the LORD commanded them. ⁷ Now Moses was eighty years old, and Aaron eighty-three years old, when they spoke to Pharaoh.

Plagues: Dismantling the "gods" of Egypt

- 1. Water to blood red (7:14-25) ... By this you shall know that I am the LORD (7:17)
 - Pharoah's heart was hard
 - Against Khnum, guardian of the Nile
- 2. Frogs (8:1-15) ... so that you may know that there is no one like the LORD
 - Pharaoh hardened his heart
 - Against Heqt goddess of birth, represented by the frog
- 3. Gnats, or sand flies, maybe fleas? (8:16-19)
 - Pharoah's heart was hard
 - Against Geb, god of the earth and dust
- 4. Swarming insects (8:20-32)...that you may know that I am the LORD in the earth
 - Pharoah hardened his heart
 - Possibly against Khepri, god of sunrise who had the head of a beetle.
- 5. Livestock die (9:1-7)
 - Pharoah's heart was hard
 - Against Ptah, god of prophecy, represented by a bull; or Hathor goddess of fertility often depicted with heat of a bull.
- 6. Boils (9:8-12)
 - The Lord hardened Pharoah's
 - Against Imhotep, the god of medicine and Isis goddess of health.
- 7. Hail (9:13-35)...so that you may know that there is none like me in all the earth.
 - Pharoah's heart was hard
 - Against Nut, the sky goddess and her father, Shue, god of wind and air
- **8.** Locust (10:1-20) ...that you may know that I am the LORD (10:2)
 - The Lord hardened Pharoah's heart
 - Against a number of gods who protected crops (Nepri, Seth, etc.)
- o. Darkness (10:21-29)
 - The Lord hardened Pharoah's heart
 - Against Amon-Ra, god of the Sun
- 10. Death of firstborn (11:1-10)
 - The Lord hardened Pharoah's heart...(11:10)

Prayers During Communion

For those searching for truth:

Lord Jesus, you claim to be the way, the truth, and the life. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me, and open to me the reality of who you are. Give me the ability to follow you no matter what it might cost me. Give me an understanding for you that is coherent, convincing, and leads to the life that you promise. Amen.

For those who desire to profess faith in Christ:

Lord Jesus, I admit that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever believed, but through you, I am more loved and accepted than I ever dared hope. I thank you for paying my debt, bearing my punishment on the cross, and offering forgiveness and new life. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead and are now representing me at the Father's right hand in heaven, I turn from my sins and receive you as my savior. Amen.

A prayer for those struggling against sin:

Lord Jesus, give me the ability to see in you the fulfillment of all my needs and desires, and help me to turn from every false source of satisfaction to feed on you, the true and living bread. Enable me to lay aside the sin that clings so closely to me and run with perseverance the race that you have set before me, looking only to you, the author and perfecter of my faith. Amen.
